2024 Priest Convocation

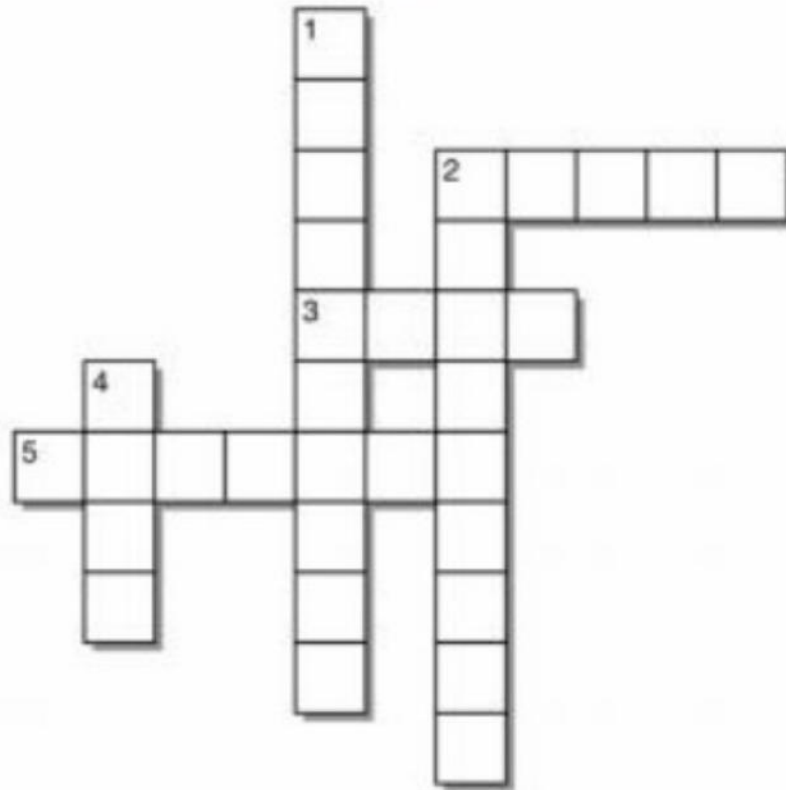
