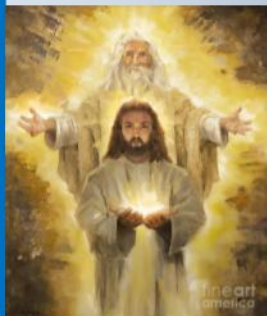






THE 4TH COMMANDMENT: "HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER"
